NOAA Satellite Conference for Direct Readout, GOES/POES, and GOES-R/JPSS Users

The theme for the Conference is “Strengthening Partnerships to Enhance User Readiness, Reception, and Utility.” Posters are requested on a wide range of topics, to include, but not limited to:

- (1) enhanced interaction, coordination, environmental satellite programs, user access;
- (2) reception and readiness for data, technology and applications from current and future polar-orbiting and geostationary environmental satellite constellations; and
- (3) use of environmental satellite data by leveraging science advances, data fusion, blended products, decision aids, advanced visualization, training, instrument and product calibration and validation, and new data assimilation techniques.

This conference is a combination of past Direct Readout, GOES Users', and Polar Max Conferences. The program committee is interested in both broad and specific examples of how users currently apply (or plan to apply) satellite information by each of these communities.
