Key datasets include NOAA and EUMETSAT Polar-orbiting operational environmental satellite data (POES and MetOp), Geostationary Operational Environmental Satellite (GOES) satellite data, Suomi National Polar-orbiting Partnership (S-NPP) satellite data and much more. All of the CLASS data holdings is free to the public and can be accessed via the web interface at www.class.noaa.gov. The NOAA's National Centers for Environmental Information's (NCEI) CLASS user engagement specialist, Axel Graumann, will be on hand to provide demonstrations and answer any questions you may have about access to CLASS or about any of the datasets within its archive".
